# Our Services

## Medical Exams

- Breast and cervical (pap smear) cancer screening for women
- Testicular screening for men
- Colposcopy and cryotherapy treatment
- Physical exams
- Sports and work exams
- TB screenings
- Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- HIV / AIDS

## Family Planning and Reproductive Health Care

- FDA approved contraceptive methods
- Pregnancy testing and counseling
- Counseling on sterilization and referrals
- Preconception / inter-conception counseling
- Natural family planning
- Fertility awareness method



## Obstetric Services

- Initial medical history and physical exam
- Pre-natal laboratory work
- TB screening
- Monitoring and regular scheduled follow-up
- Prenatal care up to 35 weeks
- Referral for labor and delivery

## Teen Pregnancy Prevention Training Facility

- Educate high risk vulnerable adolescents on both abstinence and contraception
- Provide life skills education
- Create family planning clinical linkages to provide access and availability of contraceptives and related reproductive health services.

We provide education and information to prevent unintended pregnancies, reduce high rates of teen pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections, and improve individual's sexual health and well being. We also provide prenatal care to pregnant women. These services include initial physical, regular scheduled follow-up visits, assessments through the Comprehensive Prenatal Services Program (CPSP) and referral to physicians and hospitals for delivery.

All services are CONFIDENTIAL. We accept FFACT, Medi-Cal, Medi-Cal Managed Care, Anthem Blue Cross, Health Net, and uninsured. Proof of income and legal status is NOT required.
